Michigan Adoption Resource

Exchange (MARE) is a statewide program that networks with other adoption providers and promoters in the state to maximize the effectiveness of promoting adoption and finding homes for children waiting to be adopted.

The Match Support Program is a division of MARE that provides short term (90 day) interventions for families who are in the process of adopting a child matched from the MARE website. Match Support Specialists serve families throughout the state of Michigan and utilize a strength-based, family-centered plan to guide families in finding helpful resources as well as helping them build their support system throughout the adoption process.



Services We Provide:



- ❖ Case management support and intervention -- utilizing a strengths-based, family-centered plan, services will be used to provide short term, 90 day, interventions for families in the adoption process with a child matched from the MARE website.
- *Referrals to support groups for adoptive families and their children.
- ❖ Educational training opportunities for adoptive families.
- Information and referral to appropriate community services.
